

## SHILOH BOOSTER CLUB BOARD MEETING MINUTES

### Agenda

- 1. Call to Order:** President Lisa Davis called the meeting to order at 6:37pm.
- 2. Treasurer's Report:** Financial records for the Booster Club from the 2008-2009 school year have been received by Maria from last year's Treasurer. This information includes receipts, invoices, and funds received from the Bistro and other fundraising activities.
- 3. Old Business:**
  - a. New Team Sweats: We are tabling the sweats decision until after we receive funds from the pecan sales.
  - b. Supplies Wish List: We are still reviewing the budget in order to determine what soccer supplies we can get. Below are prices for some of the equipment needed by the team. No decision needs to be made right now. We will not order supplies until mid-December, which should get here by mid-January. In the past, payments have been invoiced.
    - 1) \$15/ball from Kicks and Sticks
    - 2) Cones: \$13.50/piece @ 25/pack
    - 3) Vests: \$3.90/vest = \$195 for 50 ; Jim found some for \$157 for 50
    - 4) \$165/pr for soccer nets (w/lifetime guarantee)
- 4. New Business:**
  - A. YELLOW PAGES FUNDRAISER:** There was a meeting at Yellow pages and someone from Shiloh volunteered to go get books from Lawrenceville and bring them all back here to distribute to the various clubs. Coach Maveere was originally orchestrating this project. Coach White got information on the Yellow Pages meeting and signed Shiloh Soccer up for distribution of the books. There were four different Snellville routes available that we registered for; Lawrenceville, Suwanee, and Buford routes were also available for delivery.

Players cannot drive--there must be an adult driver with two or so players delivering to the doors. The books must be picked up from the warehouse a few days before, but must be stored somewhere at the school until the Saturday delivery. Coach White will work on a location. Finding a place to store them that we will have access to on a Saturday to get the books is currently a challenge. At the upcoming parent/player meeting on October 27<sup>th</sup> volunteers must be secured for this event.
  - B. PECAN FUNDRAISER:** Friday October 16<sup>th</sup> is the final turn in date for the pecan sales. Order date is now going to be Wed-Oct 21<sup>st</sup>. Maria will email Doreen to tell her that we will be making the order on that date. 44 boxes needs to be ordered (at least)
  - C. OTHER FUNDRAISERS:** ESPN Magazine sales—We are still considering this fundraiser, which will need to begin very shortly after the conclusion of the pecan sales. If we do not succeed in the magazine sales then we will have to pay Mike the 10% to the school regardless of the amount sold. There is still concern about the legitimacy of the ESPN magazine sales because of the “proxy” part of

the web address. SWAT team did this fundraiser, so we first should check with them to determine its effectiveness.

#### **D. OTHER NEW BUSINESS**

Our pre-season player/parent information meeting will be scheduled for Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup> at 7pm in the Media Center. Lisa will email Mike Nichols to secure that location. Things to accomplish during the meeting include:

- Collecting player/parent information on everyone (hand out and collect info sheet)
  - Both email and phone numbers is important
- Give parents a handout of the soccer program timeline
- Obtain volunteers for the various committees and chairs
  - Make sure we get volunteers for the Yellow Pages fundraisers\*
- Share information about how much money towards player fees will be credited to the player for their fundraising efforts
- Encourage both players and parents to join the Official Shiloh Soccer Facebook page
- Diane will talk about Team Parents
- Lisa will discuss the purpose of the Booster Club, the needs of the club, and a general description of the various committees
- Wendall will talk about advertising/public relations
- Tom will discuss field operations
- Maria will discuss team expenses
